Determination of the order to study for finals

For each topic below, rank them 1-5 in YOUR MIND. By writing down a 5, you are telling yourself that you could teach that topic to another student. By writing down a 1, you are telling yourself I don't remember learning this. *Focus* your studying on the 1's, 2's, and 3's. After you have done that, if time remains, then study the 4's and 5's. You should not be wasting your time studying the 4's and 5's until after everything else.

*The first time you complete this, mark the "PRE" Ranking. The Monday before your Final after you have been studying, go back and mark the "POST" Ranking. Again, be honest with yourself. You should feel confident that each number from PRE to POST should increase by 1 or stay the same. But do not increase if you don't feel it.
